



In honor of an LADHS Member, Barbara Hartley, we are offering six \$100 grants (three to University of Southern California and three to West Los Angeles College) that will be awarded to senior students.

We intend that the use of these funds will be to assist the winner with fees towards National and State licensing examinations, table clinics, etc.

The candidate will provide two character references and an up to 300-word essay on the topic:

“What I envision my contribution will be to the profession of Dental Hygiene.”

To be eligible for the grant, the senior student must:

- Be enrolled in an accredited dental hygiene program in the Los Angeles area (WLA & USC) and plan to live/work in this area
- Be a current member of SMADHA
- Attend an LADHS Board meeting (contact Tricia Osuna for meeting information)
- Submit an up to 300-word essay entitled *“What I envision my contribution will be to the profession of Dental Hygiene.”*
- Submit two character references (one from a dental hygiene instructor). Each reference should provide a brief statement (up to 50 words) on why the candidate should be considered for this award
